
the **CHILD** mortality rate. Bangladesh is already **ON TRACK** to achieving this ambitious goal,



Almost 250,000 children in Bangladesh die from preventable diseases before reaching their fifth birthday even though we have the means to SAVE them

In the past decade, Bangladesh has made faster PROGRESS on reducing child mortality among its poorest and most vulnerable than most other developing countries. We are on track to meetnewborn and child mortality. But, we still need more HELP.

WHO CAN HELP? EVERY ONE

GOAL.We already know how to prevent and treat the lies on the shoulder of EVERY ONE.

We need a massive number of people to show and inspire widespread support for the cause and build pressure for a favorable change. We cannot save the lives of EVERY CHILD until EVERY ONE cares about children dying.


SAVE THE CHILDREN and EVERY ONE


